

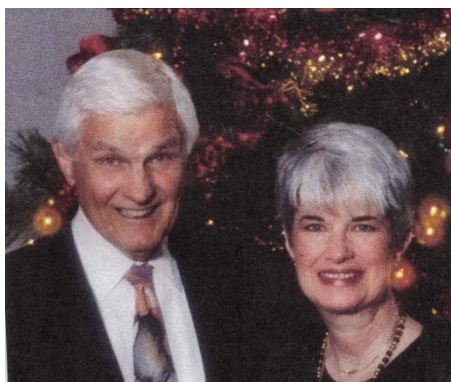
Family
