

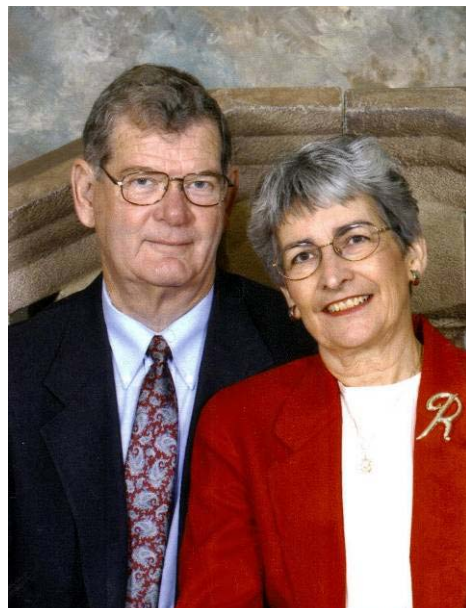
Family & Pet Friends
