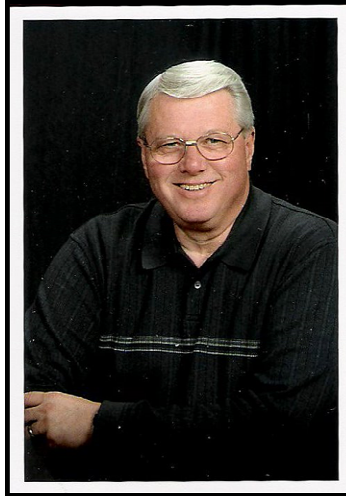


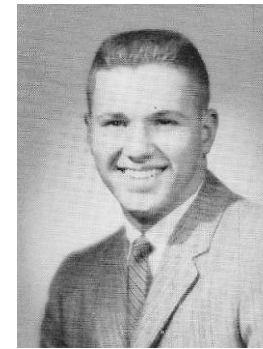
Family & Pet Friends
